Our local United Way began on April 13, 1939, when representatives of seven agencies met to lay the foundation for a Community Chest in Fayetteville. They were motivated by a "spontaneous demand on the part of the citizens for an organization to combine drives for all worthy purposes in one big campaign," according to a news report in The Fayetteville Observer.

The spirit that initiated that beginning still lives and thrives in the organization that now raises over \$1M annually for local health and human services in Cumberland County.
